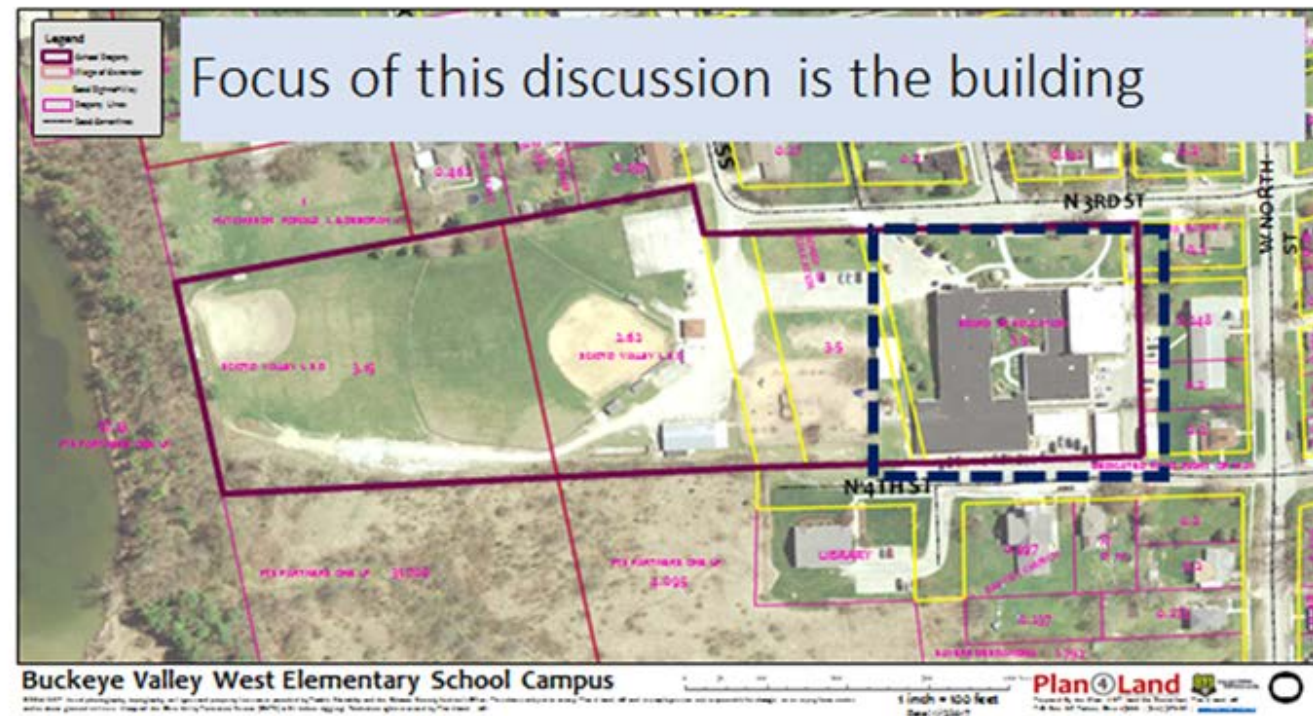


What will the Village potentially receive?

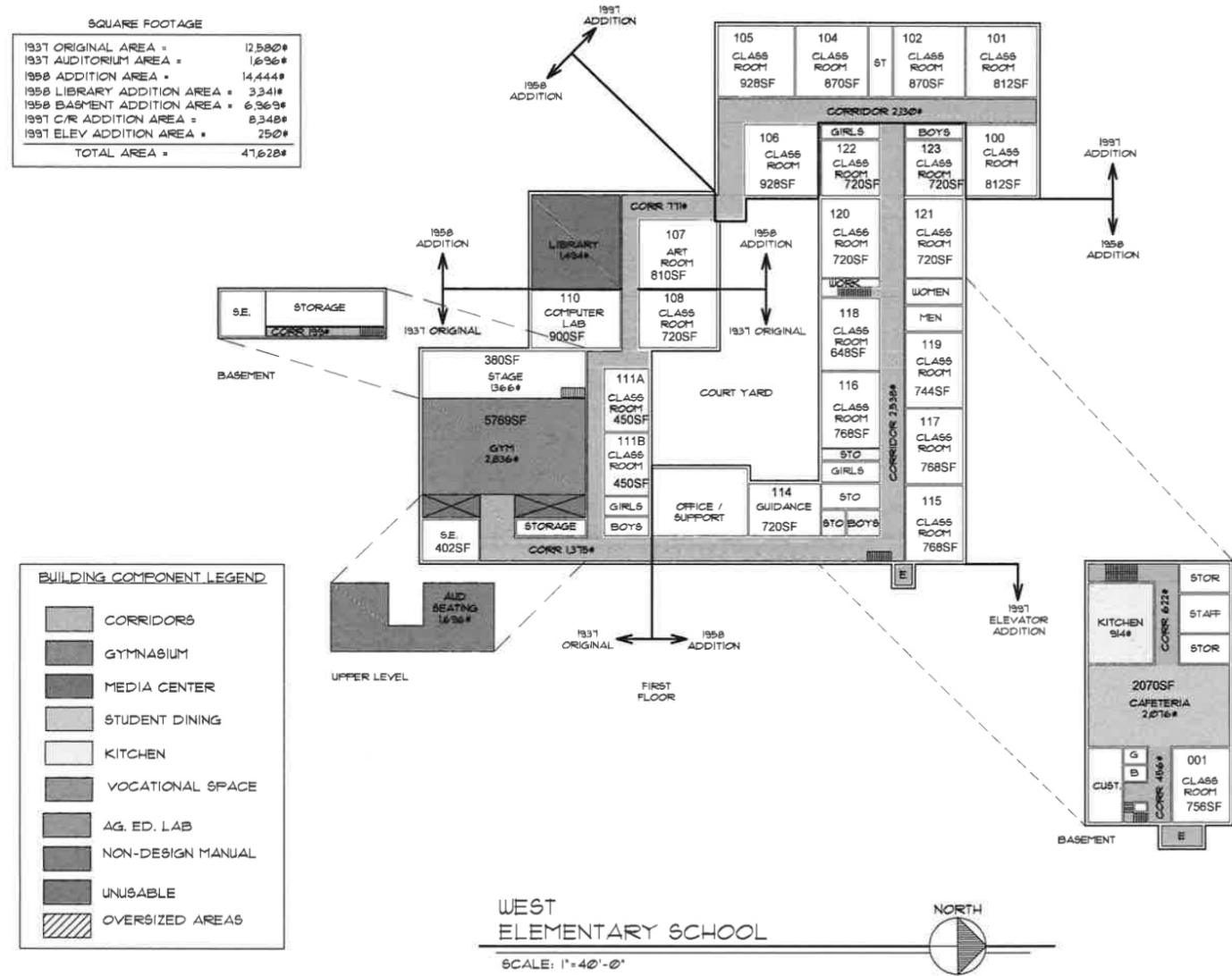
The purpose of this meeting is to provide an update regarding the facts and findings to date and to engage the community as part of the conversation and decision making process.

Situation: The Buckeye Valley Local School District citizens passed a Bond Issue to construct a new Elementary on State Rte. 257. It is scheduled to open Fall of 2018. As called for and passed in the Bond Issue, the School District has funds allocated to demolish the old BV West facility. The Village of Ostrander is working with the Buckeye Valley School District to come to agreement on the terms of a transfer.

Ideally, a transfer will take place: 1) After an agreement is voted on by the Board and Village Council, 2) After the new Elementary is complete, 3) After the School district has removed everything needed from the property, and 4) After the agreed upon demolition has been completed by the School District.

Ostrander Village Council established a Committee to explore and study the feasibility of keeping anywhere from 0% to 100% of the existing structure for Village use.
